Young visitors interested in the sector of diplomacy listen with great interest, Romain Nadal, spokesman of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and some even dare asking him questions.

Romain Nadal had the elegance of playing the game and simulating a genuine press point, as if he were facing a usual audience of journalists and correspondents of the Entire world, at the regular weekly press point. This exercise has been so well received by students and other young public, that some also lend themselves to the exercise by asking actual questions about the recent news, to the spokesman.------

QUESTION ABOUT IRAN: How is now taking place as the renewal of relations between France and Iran, and what is the French position?-----

ANSWER OF ROMAIN NADAL: Yes, the relations with Iran have been rebooted following a visit of President Rohani and his Ministry of Foreign Affairs M Javad Zarif, France, and the rapprochement of our countries is not only based on economic aspect but also diplomatic, including on the subject of the COP21, particularly on reduction of greenhouse gas. Not to mention, the consensus process is over the door since the signing of the agreement on Iranian nuclear, signed on 14 July 2015. France has also played a key role in this process before reaching an agreement.

QUESTION ABOUT SYRIA: What's France position with Syria, given the progression of Bashar Al Assad in Aleppo right now?-----

But this fact has been lasting for 5 years, causing a bloodbath, and which provides the population living under the terror and violence,

and estimated 260,000 deaths and millions of displaced refugees who go to Turkey, Jordan, and Lebanon. Laurent Fabius also explained that France has provided financial assistance to the tune of 1 billion euros, at the London conference. This tragic remarks that joined alas analysis that we had sadly anticipated, as a warning since a long time.

QUESTION ABOUT COP21: What are the impacts on the image of France abroad and the consequences after the success of the historic agreement of the COP21?------

ANSWER ROMAIN NADALI: The historic agreement was signed in the end of COP21, is based on the UN and the French diplomacy. There is no sign of arrogance here, about this great success, but this is due mainly to the Secretariat of the Framework Convention. There were all the same leadership of President Hollande and the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Laurent Fabius. The Minister had made more than a hundred trips in the world to prepare properly for the COP21.

Moreover next Friday will be a meeting with MEDEF for the continuity of the COP21. And next Saturday 13 February, Laurent Fabius will receive a prize in Munich alongside Christiana Figueres, UNFCCC Secretary General, for the contribution of the agreement set at high standard levels of the COP21 in Bourget, Paris.

On another hand, we also talked about the female mutilation knowing that 3 million girls are mutilated. France and the Netherlands have taken a resolution to fight against FGM with a slogan "Zero Tolerance" face 125 Million mutilated women in the world. We shall, by the way, keep this title for calling an International Day under "Zero Tolerance" [?], soon, explains Romain Nadal.

TO SUM UP ROMAIN NADAL EXPLAINS THE ROLE AND IMPORTANCE OF THE PRESS POINT OF SPOKESMAN AT THE MINISTRY?-----

The press conference of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs issues the official information obtained after the diplomatic corps flowing informations around the world and announce the agenda of the Minister of Foreign Affairs Laurent Fabius and Secretaries of States under the supervision of the Quai d'Orsay: "Every week on Friday we hold a press conference before journalists French and foreign correspondents, (There are around 2000 based in France coming from all over the world), releasing the news on TV, radio, web and print press. The ministry launched an initiative since January to bring the diplomatic corps of the Palestinian side and Israel closer. The same for other issues such as Zika virus. We must bring more concrete initiatives to address concerns over the epidemic and information on the affected areas. An exchange is possible by electronic means offering journalists the opportunity to ask questions on sensitive topics such as the evolution of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, or other more or less current topics." Concludes Romain Nadal Spokesman of French Foreign Affairs Ministry.
